Security is of course absolutely paramount - we use a biometric (finger print) scanning entry system and have a staffed reception.

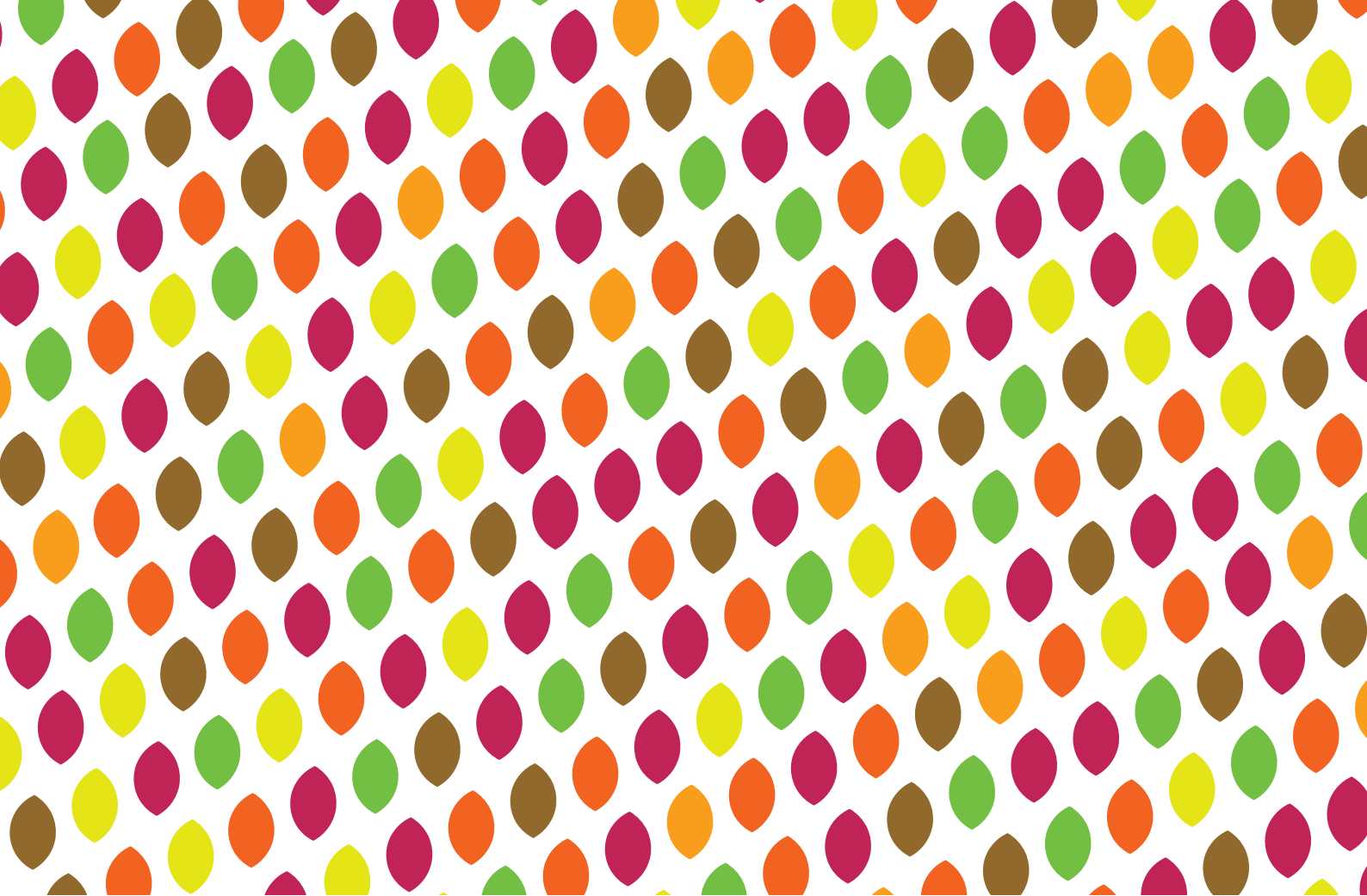
